Maintenance Mechanic

JOB SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Maintenance Manager, the incumbent performs a combination of machine maintenance, electrical, pipe fitting and carpentry duties with the goal of preventing downtime at the lowest total cost.

DUTIES

1. Installs equipment, including rigging, setting, and ancillary services.
2. Repairs machinery.
3. Performs electrical repairs not requiring skills of electrician.
4. Performs plumbing and pipe fitting new or existing installations.
5. Performs preventative maintenance operations.
6. Reports machine irregularities so that corrective action can be taken.
7. Builds platforms and guards.
8. Functions as team member or leader when assigned.
9. Follows all quality procedures and instructions.
10. Observes safety rules and works safely at all times.
11. Trains subordinates and others, as required.
12. Performs all other duties as assigned by Maintenance Manager.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Must have a High School Diploma or GED with shop or VoTech background preferred.

3. Must have training in electricity, plumbing, carpentry, hydraulics and mechanical maintenance. Must have training or experience on machine tools to include drill press, lathe, vertical mill, and surface grinder.
4. Must have 3-5 years experience in repair of machinery and equipment in a manufacturing environment.
5. Must be able to stick weld, pipefit, and rebuild dies.
6. Troubleshooting skills in hydraulics, pneumatics, electrical power and controls strongly desired.
7. Ability to operate milling machine and lathe desired.
8. Must be able to read blueprints and interpret them.
9. Must be able to satisfactorily learn to drive a forklift and pass testing to secure a Forklift driver's license.
10. Must have a valid driver's license issued by the state, a good driving record and be able to drive a pick-up.

11. Must have good or corrected eyesight including the ability to differentiate between colors. Color sight is mandatory.
12. Must be able to stoop, squat and bend, as well as push, pull and lift objects and/or equipment of various weight, size and design.

14. Must have agility of hands, wrists and arms.
15. Must be able to walk through departments, the plant and the grounds numerous times a day.
16. Must be able to climb ladders and platforms including stepping up and down from platforms and catwalks.

18. Must have the agility to work in tight areas.
19. Must be able to stand for long periods of time.
20. Must have good interpersonal skills as will be required to work with many types of personalities.
